## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Eight.

*Ordered*, That the Joint Committee on Insurance be authorized to sit during the recess of the General Court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of current house document numbered: 5779, for legislation to extend third party insurance coverage for mentally ill persons.

Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the Commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives before December 29, 1978.
