RESOLUTIONS IN RESPONSE TO THE REPRESSION OF HUMAN RIGHTS IN THE UNION OF SOUTH AFRICA, AND ELSEWHERE.

1 *Whereas*, The General Court of Massachusetts is vehemently
2 opposed to the repression of human rights, and such repression is
3 occurring in the Union of South Africa and elsewhere throughout
4 the world; therefore be it

5 *Resolved*, That the General Court of Massachusetts hereby
6 urges all banks and financial institutions within the Com-
7 monwealth to refrain from making new loans or granting credit of
8 any kind to the government of any Nation, in which human rights
9 are being repressed; and be it further

10 *Resolved*, That a copy of these resolutions be forwarded by the
11 Clerk of the House of Representatives to the commissioner of
12 banks.
