AN ACT TO AMEND THE CONDOMINIUM UNIT LAW BY PREVENTING THE  
EVICTION OF SENIOR CITIZENS IN A CONDOMINIUM UNIT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 4 of Chapter 183A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following:  
3 (4) No unit owner may recover possession of a unit occupied by a  
4 tenant who occupied the unit when the owner acquired his interest  
5 and who at the time was at least 62 years of age.
