Ordered, That the Legislative Research Council be directed to make a study and investigation relative to the use by Massachusetts cities and towns of recall election systems; and to the feasibility of a general law establishing uniform procedures and standards for such systems, to protect the franchise and rights of participation of citizens of the Commonwealth under the federal and state constitutions; the said study and investigation shall include the subject matter of current Senate document number 1361. Said Council shall file its report hereunder with the Clerk of the House of Representatives not later than the last Wednesday of February in the year nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.
