AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PRE-RETIREMENT COUNSELING PROGRAM FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 7 of the General Laws is amended by inserting after
2 Section 28A the following section: —
3 *Section 28B.* The Personnel Administrator, with the advice and
4 assistance of the Secretary of Elder Affairs and the Executive
5 Director of the Board of Retirement, shall organize and conduct
6 training sessions, instructional materials, and other programs for
7 pre-retirement counseling, suitable for all public employees. In
8 fulfilling this responsibility, the Personnel Administrator may consult
9 with representatives of labor organizations representing public
10 employees. All of the executive offices and departments of the
11 Commonwealth will assist the Personnel Administrator in dis-
12 charging this responsibility.
