AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE REGISTRATION OF MOTORBOATS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of Chapter 90B of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by section 528 of the Acts of 1972, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out paragraph (6).

1 SECTION 2. Section 3 of Chapter 90B of the General Laws as  
2 most recently amended by section 528 of the acts of 1972, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out paragraph (6).  
4 the following paragraph:—

5 (1) All vessels that have a valid marine document issued by the  
6 Bureau of customs of the United States government or any federal  
7 agency successor thereto shall be required to number their vessel  
8 with the commonwealth under the provisions of subsection (a) of  
9 this section except they will not be required to display the numbers  
10 on both sides of the bow as described in subsection (a) of this  
11 section. They will however comply with all other provisions of this  
12 chapter including the displaying of the expiration decal issued by  
13 the division upon numbering. The decal shall be displayed on the  
14 forward half of the port side of such vessel.
