AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL SALARY OF THE EXECUTIVE SECRETARY  
TO THE COMMISSION ON JUDICIAL CONDUCT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section three of Chapter 211C of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the second sentence thereof and inserting
- 3 in place thereof the following: —
- 4 The Executive Secretary shall receive an annual salary deter-
- 5 mined by the Commission and such expenses as are approved by
- 6 the Commission and which are incurred by him in the discharge of
- 7 his duties.
