The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INSTRUCTION AND SUPPORT OF SPECIAL NEEDS STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 10 of Chapter 71B of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Section 21 of Chapter 552 of the Acts of 1978, shall be
3 further amended by deleting the third paragraph and inserting in
4 place thereof the following new paragraph: —

5 The expenses of the instruction and support actually rendered or
6 furnished to such children with special needs, including their neces-
7 sary traveling expenses, whether daily or otherwise, but not exceed-
8 ing ordinary and reasonable compensation therefor, shall be paid
9 by the Commonwealth.
