AN ACT PROVIDING FOR TRANSPORTATION OF CERTAIN SCHOOL PUPILS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 76 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
2 out the paragraph of section one thereof, as most recently amended  
3 by Section 12 of Chapter 766 of the Acts of 1972 and inserting in its  
4 place the following paragraph: —

5 Pupils who, in the fulfillment of the compulsory attendance  
6 requirements of this section, attend private schools of elementary  
7 and high school grades so approved shall be entitled to the same  
8 rights and privileges as to transportation to and from school as are  
9 provided by law for pupils of public schools and shall not be denied  
10 such transportation up to a distance of ten miles because their  
11 attendance is in a school which is conducted under religious aus-  
12 pices or includes religious instruction in its curriculum, nor because  
13 pupils of the public schools in a particular city or town are not  
14 actually receiving such transportation.

15 All costs incurred by this mandatory compliance in this section  
16 shall be reimbursed fully by the Commonwealth.
