The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ISSUANCE OF NUMBER PLATES WITH "HANDICAPPED PERSON" DESIGNATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The registry of motor vehicles is hereby author-
2 ized to assign number plates with a "handicapped person" designa-
3 tion for use on motor vehicles owned by persons affiliated with
4 bona fide elder service organizations and operated primarily for
5 the transportation of handicapped elderly persons.

1 SECTION 2. Said number plates shall be issued upon written
2 verification from such an organization of the motor vehicle
3 owner's affiliation with said organization. Upon termination of the
4 owner's affiliation with said organization, the organization shall
5 notify the registry in writing, and the owner shall return the
6 number plates immediately.
