AN ACT MAKING SALARIES OF OFFICERS OF NON-PROFIT CORPORATIONS PUBLIC RECORDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 180 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 6A the following section: —

3 *Section 6B.* Records of the salaries and compensation paid to
4 offices of a corporation organized under the provisions of this
5 chapter shall be kept by the corporation, and shall be public
6 records open to inspection by any person during normal business
7 hours.
