AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE STATE BUILDING CODE COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 17 of chapter 23B of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 617 of the acts of 1979, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out clause (g) and inserting in place
4 thereof the following clause: —

5 (g) To formulate the administrative procedures and promulgate
6 rules and regulations necessary to enforce the state building code;
7 provided, however, that the commission shall make no rule or
8 regulation providing for the licensing of any individual supervising
9 persons engaged in construction, reconstruction, alteration, re-
10 pair, removal or demolition involving the structural elements of
11 buildings or structures, including an individual supervising him-
12 self, designated as a construction supervisor or however designat-
13 ed.
