AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE GRANTING OF HANDICAPPED LICENSE PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The sixth paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 387 of the acts of 1978,
3 is hereby further amended by inserting after the third sentence, the
4 following new sentence: — Such plates shall, in addition, be pro-
5 vided for a pleasure vehicle owned or leased by and used by a
6 person who suffers from a respiratory or cardiovascular condition
7 seriously impairing their mobility, which condition and impair-
8 ment have been certified to, in writing, by a physician.
