AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN ACTION ON BILLS RECEIVING A TWO-THIRDS VOTE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
- 2 after section 38A the following section: —
- 3 *Section 38A½.* Any bill receiving a two-thirds roll call vote of
- 4 approval in either branch of the general court, shall be voted upon
- 5 by the other branch.
