AN ACT DEFINING INCOME FOR THE PURPOSES OF RENT PAYMENTS IN SENIOR CITIZEN HOUSING PROJECTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 32 of chapter 121B, as most recently amended by chapter  
2 925 of the acts of 1973, is hereby further amended by adding after  
3 the third sentence the following: —

4 For the purposes of this section, any Supplemental Security  
5 Income cost of living increase received by a tenant shall not be  
6 considered income.
