RESOLVE ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL HEALTH COMMISSION.

1 *Resolved*, That a commission consisting of two members of the
2 Senate, three members of the House of Representatives, six per-
3 sons appointed by the Governor one of whom shall be a physician
4 licensed to practice in the Commonwealth, one of whom shall be a
5 registered nurse, a currently appointed Superintendent of a Massa-
6 chusetts School system, a pharmacist registered to practice in the
7 Commonwealth, a current duly elected member of a Massachu-
8 setts school committee, and a representative of the Massachusetts
9 Secondary School Administration Association, Inc.

10 The commission shall elect a chairman from its membership and
11 shall meet as they determine for the purpose of investigating the
12 existing law, rules and regulations and practices which govern the
13 current process of the taking and use of medications in the school
14 systems of the Commonwealth. The commission shall also exam-
15 ine the existing law, rules and regulations and practices governing
16 the eligibility of students to participate in interscholastic athletic
17 events after being ill or injured and make recommendations for
18 legislation or other recommendations to insure the proper medical
19 welfare of students.
