**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MAINTENANCE OF CLINICAL LABORATORIES IN PHYSICIANS' OFFICES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 4 of chapter 111D of the General Laws, as added by  
2 section 1 of chapter 881 of the Acts of 1975, is hereby amended by  
3 striking out clause (a) in the first sentence and inserting in place  
4 thereof the following new clause (a): —

5 (a) a clinical laboratory maintained exclusively in connection  
6 with the diagnosis and treatment of his or their own patients by one  
7 or more licensed physicians engaged in a solo or group practice.
