AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEDUCTION OF CERTAIN ESTATE ADMINISTRATION EXPENSES FOR ESTATE TAX PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 65C of the General Laws, as
2 inserted by chapter 684 of the acts of 1975, is hereby amended by
3 striking out paragraph (c).

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be applicable to estates of decedents
2 dying on or after January 1, 1983.
