AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE DELIVERY OF LIBRARY SERVICES TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 38H of chapter 71 of the General Laws , as enacted by
2 chapter 276 of the acts of 1965, is hereby amended by adding the
3 following paragraph to the end thereof: —

4 Each school shall contain a library and/or media center which
5 shall be staffed on a full time basis by a librarian, audio-visual
6 media specialist or unified media specialist certified under General
7 Laws Chapter 71, S38G.
