AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR APPOINTMENT TO POSITIONS
WITHIN THE OFFICE OF INSPECTOR GENERAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 388 of the Acts of 1980 is hereby amended by striking
- 2 out section three and inserting in place thereof the following: —
- 3 No person, with the exception of the attorney general, who has
- 4 served as a member of the special commission concerning state and
- 5 county buildings, established by chapter five of the resolves of
- 6 nineteen hundred and seventy-eight, nor any person who has
- 7 served in the employ of said commission, on a paid basis, shall be
- 8 eligible for appointment to any positions created as a result of the
- 9 establishment of the office of inspector general.
