### AN ACT RELATIVE TO EDUCATIONAL USES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The second paragraph of section 3 of Chapter 40A of the Gener-  
2 al Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 860 of the acts of  
3 1977, is hereby further amended by adding after the first sentence  
4 the following sentence:—

5 For the purposes of this chapter, the use of land and structures as  
6 a residential rehabilitation facility shall not be considered an edu-  
7 cational use, nor shall the facility be considered an educational  
8 facility.
