*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The fifth paragraph of Section 2 of said chapter 15A is hereby
- 2 amended by striking the word "any" so that the first sentence of
- 3 said paragraph will read: No member of said board of regents shall
- 4 be principally employed by any educational institution or by the
