AN ACT TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO CERTAIN SCHOOLS IN THE MAINTENANCE AND USE OF SCHOOL REGISTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 8 of Chapter 72 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by Chapter 1073 of the Acts of 1973, is hereby amended
- 3 by adding the following new paragraph: —
- 4 The expense incurred by private schools in the implementation
- 5 of this section shall be reimbursed 100% by the Commonwealth.
