AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE PERSONNEL ADMINISTRATOR TO CERTIFY RESIDENTS FOR POSITIONS UNDER CHAPTER THIRTY-ONE AHEAD OF NON-RESIDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 31 of the General
- 2 Laws, any city or town by ordinance or by-law may request the
- 3 Personnel Administrator to certify residents of said city or town
- 4 ahead of non-residents for appointment under this chapter and the
- 5 administrator shall certify residents ahead of non-residents accord-
- 6 ing to their eligibility.
