AN ACT RELATIVE TO CITIES AND TOWNS FURNISHING POLICE PROTECTION TO HOUSING AUTHORITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 121B is hereby amended by inserting after section 7 the
2 following section: —

3 *Section 7A.* In a city or town which accepts this section the
4 housing authority may enter into an agreement with the city or
5 town for the assignment, in such number or numbers as the author-
6 ity shall determine, of police officers of the police department of
7 the city or town to police the buildings and grounds owned by such
8 authority with the proviso that the authority shall reimburse the
9 city or town for the cost thereof. Said agreement shall also include
10 a provision that all costs incurred by the city or town in supplying
11 such police service shall, upon proper requisition, be paid by the
12 authority as such costs are incurred. The city or town shall employ
13 such additional police officers as are needed to comply with the
14 terms of the agreement.

and such other things as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this act.

SECTION 101. Short title.

This act may be cited as the "Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act."

SEC. 102. Definitions. In this act, unless the context otherwise requires—

(a) "Food" means any article (except a drug) intended for use as food for man or other animals, including any article intended to be used as a component part of such food.

(b) "Drug" means (1) articles of chemical, biological, or mechanical origin, (2) any article intended for use in the diagnosis, cure, mitigation, prevention, or treatment of disease, or (3) any article intended for use to affect the structure or function of the body.

(c) "Cosmetic" means any article intended to be applied to the human body for beautification, to protect the body, or to alter the appearance of the body.

(d) "Food additive" means any substance which is or may become a part or component of any food, the use of which in food is not generally recognized as safe by the public health officials.

(e) "Food and drug administration" means the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Administration, a department or agency of the executive branch of the Government of the United States.

(f) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Health, Education, and Welfare, or his designee.

(g) "State" means any of the several States, the District of Columbia, the Territory of Alaska, or the Territory of Hawaii.

(h) "United States" means the United States of America, including Alaska and Hawaii.

(i) "Person" means any individual, partnership, firm, corporation, or association.
