AN ACT AUTHORIZING CERTAIN LICENSED PSYCHOLOGISTS TO PERFORM EVALUATIONS FOR INVOLUNTARY TRANSPORTATION TO A MENTAL HOSPITAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 12 of chapter 123 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by sections 1 and 2 of chapter 114 of the Acts of 1975, is
3 hereby further amended in paragraph (a) by adding the words "or
4 qualified psychologist licensed pursuant to sections 118 and 129 of
5 chapter one hundred twelve," after the word "twelve" in the first
6 sentence; by adding the words "qualified psychologist" after the
7 word "physician" in the second sentence; and by adding the words
8 "or qualified psychologist" after the word "physician" in the third
9 sentence.
