AN ACT RELATIVE TO REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTION FOR PARENTS WHO HAVE CHILDREN IN STATE OR PRIVATE COLLEGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of Chapter 59 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by adding a new clause Forty-seven so that the new clause shall
3 read as follows: —

4 “Real property to the value of \$4,000.00 or the sum of \$500.00
5 whichever would result in a greater amount of a person whose
6 children are enrolled in a state college or a private college.
