AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF GROUPS ELIGIBLE UNDER GROUP FOUR RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The definition of group four (4) in paragraph (G) of subdivision
2 (2) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the words "said employees" in line 23,
4 as appearing in section 2 in chapter 626 of the Acts of 1974 the
5 words; "Drinking water operations licensed under the provisions
6 of section 66B of chapter 13."
