AN ACT CREATING A STATE TAX EXEMPTION FOR ALL RESIDENT MILITARY RETIREES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 5 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as most recently
- 2 amended by section 1 of chapter 723 of the acts of 1973, is hereby
- 3 further amended by adding the following paragraph: —
- 4 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the
- 5 first four thousand dollars of retired pay for all members of the
- 6 armed forces of the United States, shall be exempt from income
- 7 tax.
