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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

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AN ACT TO ESTABLISH TUITION FOR ACADEMIC REMEDIAL TUTORING FOR CHILDREN UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE JUVENILE COURTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 46 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding  
2 after section 46M, the following new section: —

3 *Section 46N.* The department shall provide tuition in the public  
4 schools of any city, town or regional school district, for any school  
5 age child placed under the jurisdiction of the court, and found by  
6 the court to be in need of academic remedial tutoring. The superin-  
7 tendent of schools, or teachers insofar as authorized by him or the  
8 school committee shall grant at the court's order an additional  
9 three hours per week of academic remedial tutoring when such  
10 court determines that the welfare of the child will be better served  
11 through the granting of such tutoring.
