AN ACT LIMITING CONSECUTIVE TERMS OF OFFICE OF APPOINTED MEMBERS OF HOUSING AUTHORITIES IN CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first sentence of the fifth paragraph of section 5 of chapter
- 2 129B, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 75, of the acts of 1961, is
- 3 hereby amended by inserting after the word "expiration", in line 3,
- 4 the words: -; provided, that in a city no appointive member of a
- 5 housing authority shall serve more than one consecutive term.
