## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE FULL PAYMENT OF TUITION COSTS OF CITY AND TOWN CLERKS ATTENDING THE NEW ENGLAND MUNICIPAL CLERKS INSTITUTE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Not withstanding any special Act or General Law to the con-
- 2 trary, the Commonwealth of Massachusetts is hereby directed to
- 3 assume the costs for tuition for attendance and enrollment at the
- 4 New England Municipal Clerks Institute, by the Commonwealth's
- 5 Municipal Clerks, conducted annually by the New England Asso-
- 6 ciation of City and Town Clerks.
