## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR MODIFICATION OF CERTAIN LAWS RELATIVE TO SMALL BUSINESS.

- 1     *Resolved*, That existing State research and development pro-  
2     curement, assistance, and tax law and policies must be modified  
3     and new laws enacted to: —  
4     1) eliminate unfair advantages enjoyed by governmental agen-  
5     cies, nonprofit agencies and educational institutions which com-  
6     pete with innovative small business in providing goods and serv-  
7     ices;  
8     2) mandate statutorily a state policy of reliance on small busi-  
9     ness;  
10    3) prevent the state government from disseminating proprietary  
11    information; and  
12    4) prevent the State government through the use of its own  
13    personnel from competing with small business.
