AN ACT REGULATING UTILITY RATE EXPENDITURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- The department of public utilities shall prohibit the inclusion of
- 2 any monies expended for industry dues, lobbying or trade organi-
- 3 zations by utility companies in the cost of service, operating ex-
- 4 penses or any consumer sponsored charges whatsoever. All such
- 5 charges must be fully borne by stockholders of the utility company
- 6 making said expenditures.
