AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SUDBURY RIVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section four of Chapter 177 of the Acts of 1872 is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the first sentence thereof the words "one
- 3 and one half million gallons per day" and substituting therefor the
- 4 words "twenty million gallons a day."
