AN ACT RELATIVE TO DOG LICENSES AND FINES IN THE TOWN OF HOLDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one
2 hundred and thirty-nine of chapter one hundred and forty of the
3 General Laws or any other provision of law to the contrary, the
4 annual fees to be charged by the Town of Holden for the issuance
5 of licenses for dogs shall be set by the Board of Selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one
2 hundred and forty-seven of said chapter one hundred and forty or
3 any other provision of law to the contrary, all money received from
4 the sale of dog licenses by the Town of Holden, or recovered as
5 fines, penalties or forfeitures for violating any of the provisions of
6 said chapter one hundred and forty relating to dogs, shall be paid
7 into the treasury of said Town of Holden and shall not thereafter be
8 paid over by the Town Treasurer to the County of Worcester.
