AN ACT RELATING TO THE TRANSFER OF URBAN REDEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 18B of Chapter 121A of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking the period at the end of the fifth sentence
3 thereof, by substituting a semicolon, and by adding thereafter the
4 following:—

5 Provided, however, that no such certificate shall be issued until
6 the city or town within which the project is located receives from
7 the transferring corporation a payment equal to the difference
8 between any payments actually made for the project under sections
9 six A, ten, and fifteen, and the real estate tax including interest
10 annually at the rate permitted under chapter fifty-nine which
11 would have been paid if the project had not been exempt from the
12 real estate taxation under this chapter.
