## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN PROPERTY DAMAGE CLAIMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 34-O of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amend-  
2 ed by inserting at the end of the eighth paragraph the following  
3 sentence: The insurer shall not, however, be required to make full  
4 payment without regard to comparative negligence or any deducti-  
5 ble where the determination of negligence attributable to an in-  
6 sured as being fifty percent or less has been made by the Board of  
7 Appeal on Motor Vehicle Liability Policies and Bonds in instances  
8 wherein the insured vehicle is unable to identify the other vehicle  
9 which the insured claims caused his loss.
