AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF THE REQUIREMENT THAT PUBLIC EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH TAKE A "LOYALTY OATH", AND FURTHER PROVIDING THE REPEAL OF THE LAW DEALING WITH FINES AND IMPRISONMENT FOR THE VIOLATION OF SAID OATH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Sections fourteen and fifteen of chapter two hundred and sixty-
- 2 four of the General Laws are hereby repealed.
