AN ACT QUALIFYING CERTAIN EMPLOYEES FOR THE POSITION OF AREA COORDINATORS IN THE OFFICE FOR CHILDREN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any special or general law to the  
2 contrary, the Personnel Administrator shall, within thirty days of  
3 the effective date of this act, establish a qualifying examination  
4 procedure for the certification of provisional employees serving in  
5 the position of Assistant Coordinators in the Office for Children.  
6 Upon the completion of the examination procedure, the Adminis-  
7 trator shall certify any employee who served in the position of  
8 Assistant Coordinator or Specialist in Early Childhood Education  
9 as a provisional employee for a period of at least six months  
10 immediately prior to the effective date of this act or any provisional  
11 employee who had previously passed the civil service examination  
12 for such position.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on its passage.
