### **AN ACT REDEFINING CERTAIN PAYMENTS TO THE BENEFICIARIES OF STATE EMPLOYEES.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of L.V. 5, as found in the Uni-
- 2 versity of Massachusetts Red Book, so-called, or any other general
- 3 or special law to the contrary, the Treasurer of the Commonwealth
- 4 shall, upon the death of an employee of the Commonwealth, pay to
- 5 his duly designated beneficiary a sum equal to the total value of all
- 6 sick leave and vacation benefits which the said employee had
- 7 accrued during the entire length of his service.
