By Mr. Nagle of Northampton, petition of William P. Nagle, Jr., relative to further regulating the transfer of certain vehicular bridges over tracks or rights-of-way of railroads to the Department of Public Works. Transportation.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN VEHICULAR BRIDGES OVER TRACKS OR RIGHTS-OF-WAY OF RAILROAD TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 634 of the Acts of 1971, as amended, is further amended
- 2 by striking out the second paragraph of Section 2 in its entirety and
- 3 inserting in place thereof the following paragraph: —
- 4 Following acquisition of said bridges by the department, the
- 5 railroad corporations shall furnish, without cost to the depart-
- 6 ment, necessary flag protection on the railroad rights of way which
- 7 may be required when the department is performing inspection of
- 8 any such bridge. The department shall assume responsibility for
- 9 the cost of necessary flag protection on the railroad right of way
- 10 when performing reconstruction or replacement of such bridge.
