AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE METHOD OF FILLING A VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF COUNTY OR ASSOCIATE COMMISSIONER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 144 of chapter 54 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 4 of chapter 31 of the acts of 1939, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out the final paragraph and inserting
4 in place thereof the following paragraph: —

5 Also upon such vacancy, the two remaining county commission-
6 ers and the clerk of the courts for the county, or a majority of them,
7 may appoint, from a list of three persons approved by the county
8 advisory board, a person, not a resident of the same town as either
9 of the remaining commissioners, to fill the office of county com-
10 missioner until a person is elected thereto and qualified.
