By Mr. Alexander of Marblehead, petition of Lawrence R. Alexander (by vote of the town) that provision be made for the appointment of the treasurer in the town of Marblehead by the board of selectmen of said town. Local Affairs. [Local Approval Received.]

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE TREASURER IN THE TOWN OF MARBLEHEAD BY THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN OF SAID TOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section one of
2 chapter forty-one of the General Laws or of any other contrary
3 provision of law, commencing May tenth, nineteen hundred and
4 eighty-two, the treasurer of the town of Marblehead each year shall
5 be appointed by the board of selectmen of said town, for a term of
6 one year, and the person so appointed shall have all the powers and
7 duties now or from time to time vested by law in the office of the
8 treasurer. The town of Marblehead may establish by by-law such
9 qualifications for said office as it deems necessary and appropriate.
10 Any vacancy in such office shall be filled in like manner for the
11 unexpired portion of the term.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on upon its passage.
