AN ACT MAKING JUNE SEVENTEENTH A FULL LEGAL HOLIDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out clause Eighteenth, as most recently amended by chap-
3 ter 12 of the acts of 1978, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following clause: —

5 Eighteenth, "Legal holiday" shall include January first, January
6 fifteenth, June seventeenth, July fourth, November eleventh, and
7 Christmas Day, or the day following when any of said days occur
8 on Sunday, and the third Monday in February, the third Monday
9 in April, the last Monday in May, the first Monday in September,
10 the second Monday in October, and Thanksgiving Day. "Legal
11 holiday" shall also include, with respect to Suffolk county only,
12 March seventeenth, or the day following when said day occurs on
13 Sunday; provided, however, that the words "legal holiday" as used
14 in section forty-five of chapter one hundred and forty-nine shall
15 not include March seventeenth, or the day following when said day
16 occurs on Sunday.
