By Mr. Cohen of Newton, petition of David B. Cohen for legislation to limit certain regulatory powers of the Board of Public Accountancy. Government Regulations.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT LIMITING CERTAIN REGULATORY POWERS OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTANCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The board of public accountancy shall in its regulations provide
- 2 that the fee for attending board related courses shall not exceed six
- 3 dollars per credit hour and that an accountant who has attained
- 4 age seventy shall not be required to attend more than fifteen hours
- 5 of course time in any year unless he practices before and must meet
- 6 security exchange commission requirements. Said regulations
- 7 shall further provide that a disabled accountant shall be required to
- 8 complete courses only in the ratio that the time worked in a year
- 9 bears to normal full time employment.
