**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTERING OF BARBER'S ASSISTANTS.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 871 of chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amend-  
2 ed by adding the following five paragraphs: —

3 Any person who is qualified to register as a barber's assistant  
4 who is at least sixteen years of age and pays the required registra-  
5 tion fee shall be issued by the board, on a biennial basis, a registra-  
6 tion card as a barber's assistant. Such registration card shall state  
7 the name of the person registered, the period of such registration,  
8 and the name and address of the barbershop in which such person  
9 is initially registered to work as a barber's assistant.

10 Whenever any registered barber's assistant leaves the employ of,  
11 or ceases to work within, the barbershop named on his registration  
12 card, the registration shall automatically be revoked at the expira-  
13 tion of thirty days from the date of his departure unless the regis-  
14 trant applies for and pays the fee for transfer of the registration to  
15 the new barbershop in which the registrant is to work. Any such  
16 application for transfer shall automatically be granted by the  
17 board for the unexpired term of registration, and a new registra-  
18 tion card shall thereupon be issued as soon as practicable.

19 A barber's assistant shall not practice barbering except to sham-  
20 poo hair and apply hair tonics or conditioner under the supervision  
21 of a licensed barber.

22 Violation of the preceding paragraph constitutes grounds for  
23 revocation of the barber's assistant's certificate.

24 The board shall keep a record relating to the issuance, transfer,  
25 and revocation of registration cards. Such record shall contain the  
26 name, place of business, and residence of each barber's assistant  
27 and the date and number of his registration card.
