The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT REQUIRING CORPORATIONS WITH ASSETS OR BUDGETS OVER A CERTAIN AMOUNT TO PRESENT DEVELOPMENT PLANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, any
2 corporation organized under chapters 155 through 158, inclusive,
3 of the General Laws, with assets and budget in excess of four
4 million dollars, shall develop within two years of the passage of this
5 act, a short range and long range development plan and present
6 said plans to contiguous neighborhood groups. The short range
7 plan shall, for a two year period, and the long range plan shall, for a
8 twenty-five year period, list all of the real property owned by the
9 corporation, the corporation's plan for compliance with the mu-
10 nicipality's housing assistance, details on environmental impact
11 and local employment impact statements.
