AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE GROUP INSURANCE COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3 of Chapter 32A of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Chapter 958 of the Acts of 1977, is hereby further
3 amended by striking out in the first sentence the words "seven
4 members" and inserting in place thereof the words "nine members"
5 and by inserting after the words "a retired state employee," the
6 words "a member of Local 254, S.E.I.U., AFL-CIO," and by
7 striking out in the second sentence the word "four" and inserting in
8 place thereof the word "five".
