RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE DELIVERY OF HEALTH CARE AND RELATED SERVICES TO SENIOR CITIZENS IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of four members  
2 of the senate, seven members of the house of representatives, and  
3 three persons to be appointed by the governor, one of whom shall  
4 be the president of the Massachusetts Association of Older Ameri-  
5 cans or his designee, is hereby established for the purpose of  
6 making an investigation and study a relative to the proper and  
7 necessary functions of the commonwealth in the planning and  
8 delivery of health care and related services to senior citizens. Said  
9 commission is also directed to assess and to make recommenda-  
10 tions relative to the indentification of the health care and related  
11 needs.

12     Said commission shall file its final report with the clerk of the  
13 house of representatives on or before the last Wednesday of  
14 March, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.

15     Said commission may travel throughout the commonwealth.
